FLAME will support the many ways that teachers are combining languages with other subjects, whether bringing subject topics into language lessons, teaching subject modules or teaching one or more whole subjects through a language other than English.

Plans for **FLAME** include:

- 🔥 **bringing together** people with an interest in bilingual learning,
- 🔥 **helping teachers** to collaborate and share ideas,
- 🔥 **providing information and advice** for schools,
- 🔥 **arranging 'open days'** to see CLIL and bilingual learning in action, and
- 🔥 **improving the availability** of learning resources.

We hope that the **FLAME** initiative will increase the number of primary and secondary schools that combine subject and language teaching, and that in this way we can help to transform the quality of language learning in schools.



FLAME will launch formally in January 2013.
