Language Teacher of the Year Awards 2017

Many of us know a very special language teacher – a teacher who inspires and motivates pupils through superb, innovative teaching; who engages young learners, opening their eyes and broadening their horizons – and a teacher who supports colleagues by sharing their expertise and ideas.

The Language Teacher of the Year Awards were established to recognise and celebrate the talent and hard work of language teachers in the UK. The Awards were created in England in 2014, with help from Routes into Languages and funding from the Higher Education Funding Council for England. They are now continuing into 2017 – and expanding throughout the UK – thanks to funding from the Association for Language Learning (ALL), the UK's major subject association for teachers of languages, and generous sponsorship from Early Start Languages and Halsbury Travel.

ALL are looking for nominations in two categories for the 2017 awards – which are open to teachers across the UK:

- The **Primary Language Teacher of the Year Award** for an outstanding primary teacher of languages (sponsored by Early Start Languages)
- The Secondary Language Teacher of the Year Award for an inspirational secondary languages teacher (sponsored by Halsbury Travel)

The aim of both Awards is to support and promote language teaching and to raise the profile of language teaching as a career, recognising exciting, motivating practice among language teachers, and celebrating imaginative teaching which inspires language learning in pupils. The closing date for nominations is **Friday 21 October 2016**.

The presentation of the 2017 Awards will take place took place on Saturday 25 March 2017 at Language World 2017 in Nottingham – the event of the year for language teachers, and a chance to celebrate success with the rest of the UK language teaching community.
