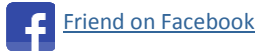

[ALL Connect](#) has also delivered **face-to-face training** in three regions (the **East, North East and North Midlands**). Regional Coordinators in each region delivered training to teams of ALL Connect Lead Teachers, who then returned to their local centres and delivered the training to language teachers in their local areas. Training sessions have now taken place in all three regions, in around 30 local centres – that's up to 300 twilight sessions, benefitting around 4,000 teachers across the country!
