Nurturing Cultural Curiosity through Free Online Resources

It has never been easier to find interesting and engaging teaching materials; the internet gives us immediate access to a whole range of authentic resources which we can use in our languages classrooms. However, we often need to adapt these resources to make them accessible to our learners and think of creative ways to use them within our schemes of work.

The materials we use in our languages lessons should be:

- Accessible: they should be convenient to access for the teacher, whilst at the same time intelligible to the learner
- Authentic: texts and accompanying tasks should be perceived as having a real-life communicative purpose
- **Appropriate**: the material should be suitable for the topic in hand, as well as for the age group and ability and language level of the learners

During this session, Liz will share examples of a range of authentic (and often free!) resources and discuss ideas and practical strategies of how to use them creatively classes across Key Stages 2 and 3, ensuring differentiation and progression, as well as engagement and motivation, so that all our learners are supported in our busy classrooms.

(Examples will be in French / German / Spanish, but they can always be adapted!)

Speaker: Liz Black

Liz Black has experience across the whole spectrum of language teaching: she has many years of teaching experience in primary and secondary schools, and delivers training to teachers in all Key Stages. She is currently the MFL PGCE Curriculum Area Leader at the University of York and a part-time DLL teacher trainer at the Goethe Institut, London. She is also a well-known speaker nationally who is highly regarded for her engaging and creative ideas for the classroom.
