He has his own consultancy company (All About Educational Ltd) which provides CPD and in-house INSET in the UK and abroad. He has worked on international education / development projects in France, Switzerland, Kazakhstan, Hong Kong and the Caribbean, as well as the British Council's Connecting Classrooms project.
