Title: **Listen, Speak, Read, Write, Web: Personalised and creative ways of engaging and extending pupils with ICT**

Aim of Course:

To show how a range of free web tools can enhance all four skills and channel learners' creativity with technology they are passionate about and enjoy using in their free time.

Description:

In the first hands-on session we shall explore effective ways of rehearsing and peer assessing spoken work, raising pupils' confidence and improving pronunciation using free tools Audacity, Cue Prompter, Levelator, Voki and Posterous. You will learn how easy it is to record and edit digital audio, produce professional looking resources and publish the results on the web.

The second hands-on session looks at how pupils can practise their reading and writing skills by contributing to an online notice board, creating a cool animated cartoon and making a decorative word cloud with Wallwisher, Domo Animate and Wordle. We shall also learn how to use a free Word template Teacher's Pet (PC only) which can produce a range of language learning exercises in a few clicks including matching activities, gapfills and multiple choice exercises. A great timesaver for busy teachers!

Learning Outcomes: Participants will gain the skills they need to replicate what they have learnt and be able to incorporate the ideas into their own practice for their learners of all abilities.

Methods of Delivery: Tutor led, discussion and workshops

Target Audience: Teachers of modern languages to primary and secondary school students; heads of modern languages in secondary schools who are keen to find out ways they can use technology to enhance their language lessons and network with other like-minded colleagues in their local area and further afield.
