‘Using cinema in the MFL classroom’: How film can inspire and enthuse

Adalgisa Serio, co-author of "Collana Cinema Italia" by Edilingua, will illustrate examples and activities of how to exploit whole films and/or film sequences in the process of language learning. The film, in fact, is the most powerful tool to present cultural, social, political, historical and economical insights of a foreign country while practising a foreign language. The session will also include the presentation of a joint project in conjunction with the ‘Cornerhouse’, where year 10 students had to create a video-clip in the target language as conclusion of the work they had done on the Italian film "Pranzo di Ferragosto".
