

ALL: President Elect

In ALL there is a Presidential team – President, Past President and President Elect.

Each member of the team serves for three years and takes on the role of President in year two.

The first year of office, as President Elect, provides the opportunity to join the team of ALL trustees (all officers of the Association automatically become trustees) and thus be part of the Management Board of ALL. This gives the incoming President the chance to learn about ALL from the inside, as well as see what's involved in being President.

Different people bring different skills and expertise to the role as President and no two Presidents do exactly the same job. However, what's common to all is the representation of ALL at events and meetings around the country (so there's some travel involved), being at the heart of the organisation of the Language World conference, attending meetings of trustees (four meetings a year) and the ALL Executive (twice a year, chaired by the Past President) and generally being a public face of ALL in their year of office.

Being on the ALL Presidential team is demanding and time-consuming, but we do our best to fit around the work patterns of our Presidents, who usually have busy professional lives. There is no remuneration for being on the team, but all out of pocket expenses are covered.
