Differentiation and

How can we motivate and engage all our children from the first day of their language learning all the way to them taking their final examinations?

Differentiation is a key issue language teachers need to consider, whether they teach in primary schools or preparing students for GCSE and beyond. We need to ensure all our learners make progress at a level in keeping with their ability if we want to keep them engaged and motivated beyond their first few lessons. This event, aimed at both **KS2 and KS3 MFL** teachers, will look at practical strategies for the classroom and explore resources that lend themselves for differentiation so that all our learners can access them at their level of ability.

Transition between key stages, and in particular between primary and secondary school is crucial if we want to ensure that prior learning is not wasted but built upon. The ALL Connect Transition Toolkit is a practical, useful guide containing a set of 'tools' (ideas, strategies and resources), designed to inform the process of transition in languages teaching and learning between KS2 and KS3. It has been developed and published as part of the Association for Language Learning ALL Connect programme, funded by the Department for Education. The materials are aimed at an audience of teachers teaching pupils at KS2 and KS3.
