Getting There

By Tube

Westminster Academy is a 2 minute walk from Royal Oak tube station (Hammersmith & City line). When exiting the station turn right, after 50 yards you will reach the Harrow Road. From here turn left, following the main road. Westminster Academy is located just past the Shell petrol station on the left hand side of the road.

By Rail

Westminster Academy is a 15 minute walk from Paddington Train Station. A cab may be taken from the station taxi rank or alternately exit via the Bishop's Bridge Road and turn right onto the Harrow Road (see map opposite).

By Road

Westminster Academy is located next to the Paddington exit of the A40 Westway.

We would advise you not to come by private car: parking spaces are scarce and expensive in this area of London.
