

# General Information & Administration

## Accommodation

Accommodation will consist of en-suite accommodation in Imperial College. All bedrooms are serviced daily and delegates will be provided with a welcome pack containing coffee, tea, sugar, and milk sachets. Soap and towels, cups, kettle, and a lamp are provided. Internet access (charged at £5 and bookable at the main accommodation reception desk) is available in bedrooms.

Your joining letter will confirm your accommodation booking. This document should be carried with you at all times during the conference.

When you arrive at Imperial, please make your way to the Halls of Residence around Princes Gardens (Southside). Participants can check in to their rooms after 14.00 on the day of arrival. There is a 24 hour reception desk. If you arrive before 14.00 there is a place to leave luggage. Please inform us if you will be arriving after 21.00 as we will need to make staff on the reception desk aware of this.

Bedrooms must be vacated and keys returned to main accommodation reception desk by 10.00 on the day of departure. Luggage may be left at the main accommodation reception desk.

Imperial College has a strict no-smoking policy and smoking is not permitted in any of the residences or in the residence grounds.

If you require accommodation, you are advised to book as early as possible as availability cannot be guaranteed.

## Car parking

There are no parking places for delegates at Imperial College. We advise delegates to travel to London by public transport to avoid high parking rates and the congestion charge (Thursday and Friday).

## Cloakrooms

There will be an attended cloakroom area in the Exhibition Centre. Please note that valuable items such as laptops should not be left in the cloakroom. All items are left at the owner's risk. Participants should note that neither the Association for Language Learning nor Imperial College can accept responsibility for loss or damage to personal property at this event.

## Meals

Breakfast for residents will be served in the Senior Common Room in the Sherfield Building between 7:30 - 10:30.

Coffee and lunch is included in the conference fee and will be served in the Exhibition. You will be asked to produce your conference badge and ticket when collecting your coffee or lunch to show you are a conference delegate.

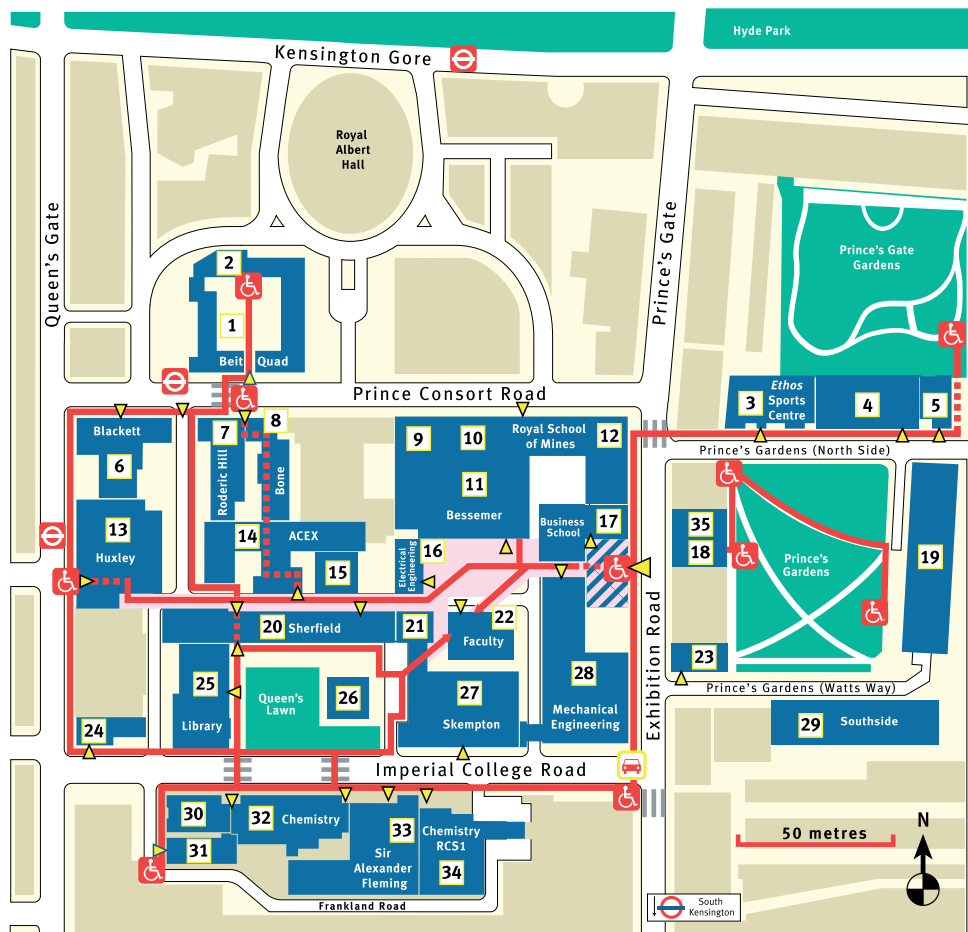

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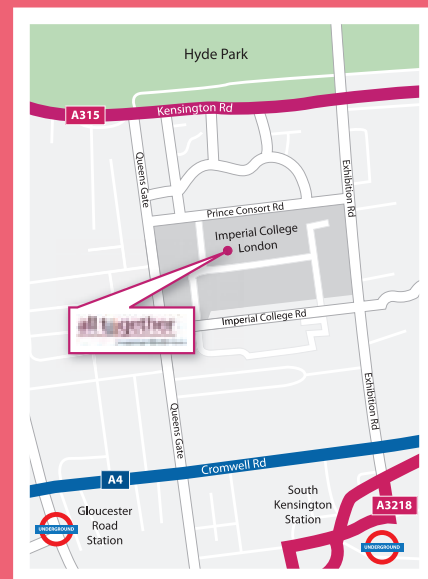
