Before the Conference

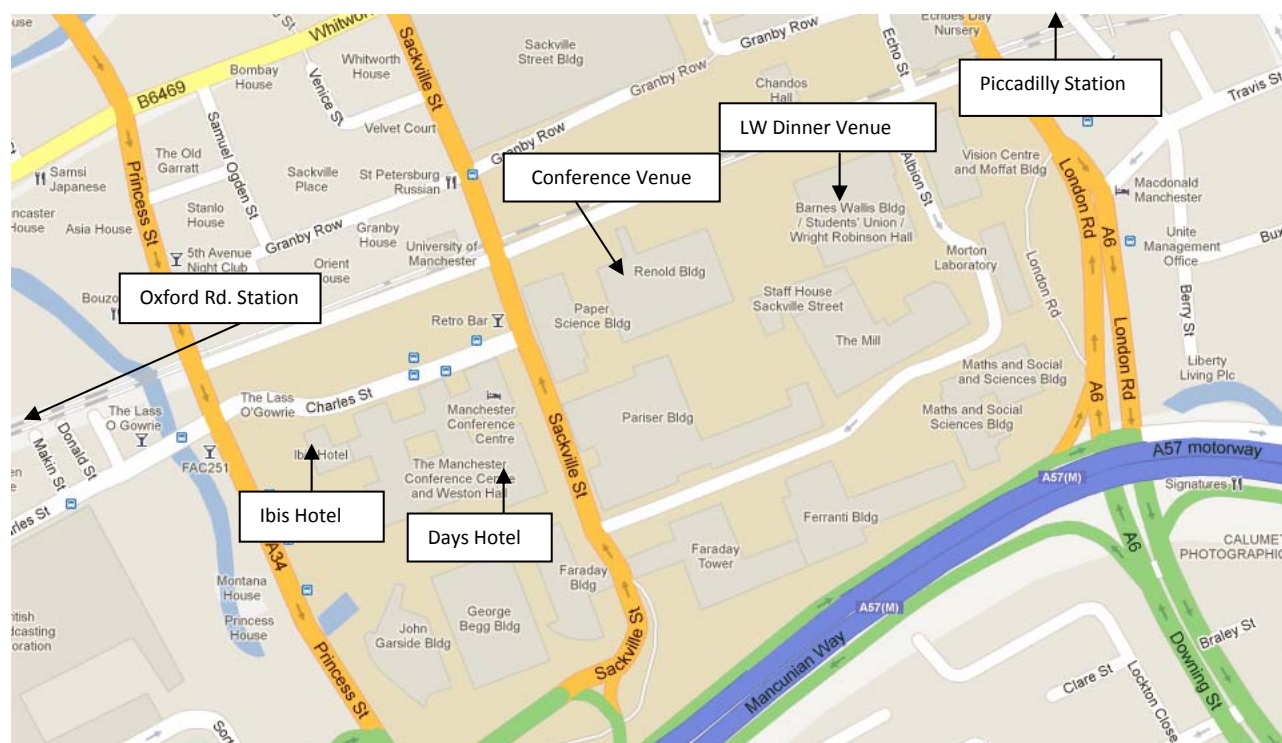
Venue
