An in-depth study of 4 cases that combine language learning and sport in English secondary schools

- × What are the benefits of combining sport and languages?
- × What are the problems that we face in secondary schools when linking sports and languages?
- × How can we improve the quality of languages and sport projects?



Benefits of combining languages and sport

- × Providing a purpose for the language use
- × Providing opportunities for kinaesthetic learning
- × Ensuring high levels of pupil engagement
- × Raising motivation for PE and for language learning



The problems

- × Departmental structure of secondary schools
- × Timetabling issues
- × Access to PE spaces
- × Not all our pupils share our passion for sport



Case A: The Transition Model or „All that we did, we worked together“

- × Language Olympics Day to aid transition for year 6
- × All languages staff and Y10 language leaders involved
- × Carousel activities that practise language in a kinaesthetic way



Case B: The Long-term Model or “Blurring the line between what’s a PE lesson and what’s a language lesson”

- × Using language lesson time for a practical approach
- × Mixture of classroom-based lessons and lessons in the sports hall
- × All language learning is linked to a practical purpose, e.g. delivering a training session, organising a basketball tournament, etc.



Case C: The Immersion Day Model or “It’s different and that makes it more exciting”

- × Offering a fitness lesson in the foreign language as part of an immersion day on health and fitness
- × Pupils creating their own aerobics routine and then completing a fitness circuit

Case D: The Key Stage 4 Model or “How learning a language is a practical skill like PE”

- × Linking fitness training to controlled assessment on health and fitness
- × Working out while memorising language structures and vocab
- × Writing about their experiences in their controlled assessment

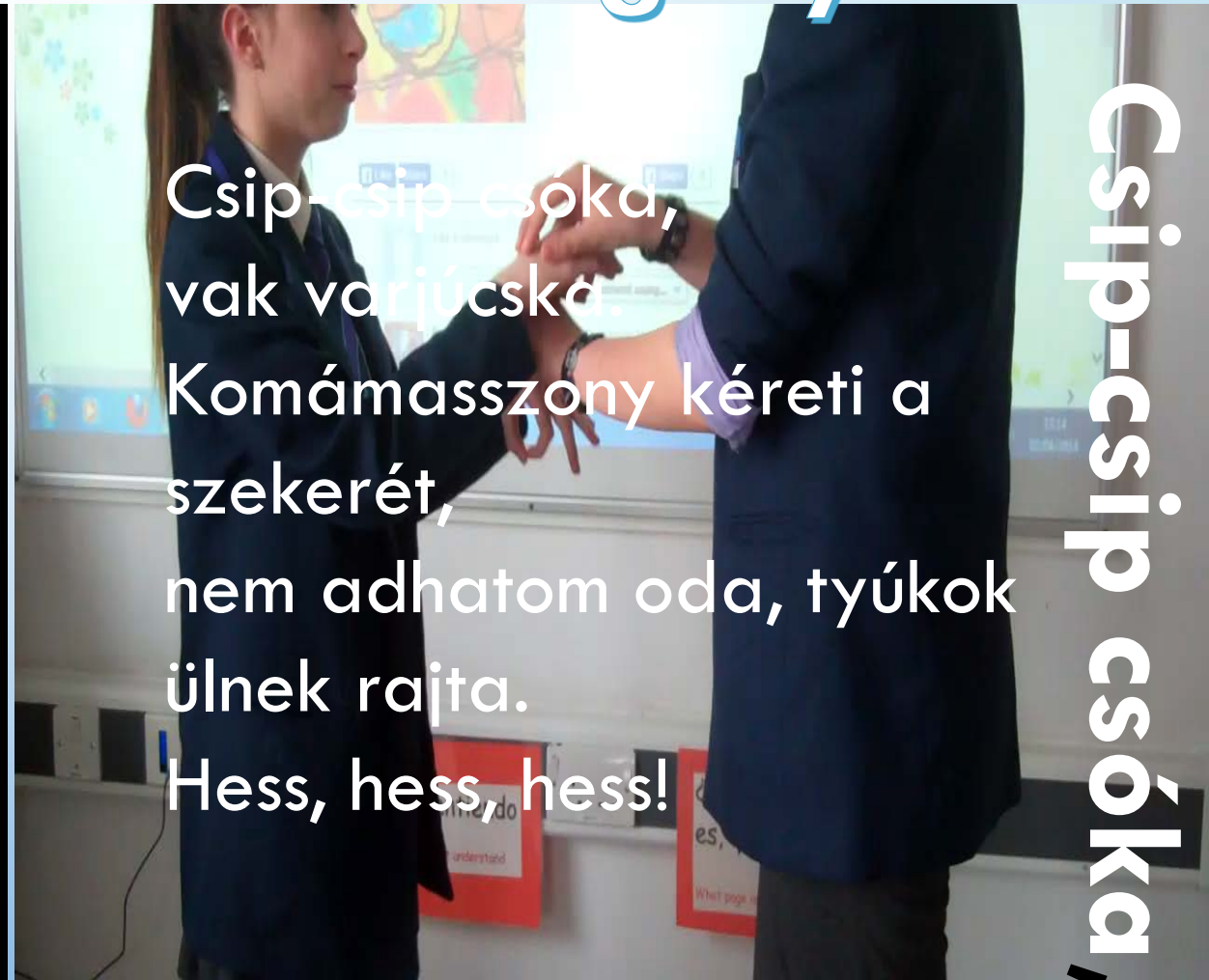
