Benefits of a multi-lingual model...

FLEXIBLE: can adapt to a school's current and future situations (eg staff changes/mixed ages)

SUPPORTIVE: of the non-specialist who won't need to take any language to too high a level

PRIMARY: promoting 'joined-up ' curriculum thinking (especially with English)

TRANSITION –FRIENDLY: creates a 'foundation' for KS3; sends language aware pupils to Y7 with no single language studied for four years

FUTURE-RESILIENT: teaching English speakers the skills needed to learn any language


 Primary Modern Languages: the impact of teaching approaches on attainment and preparedness for secondary school language learning (Funded by the Nuffield Foundation)

 Looked at the kind of learning in primary school that best prepares learners for further study of languages at KS3



Research results

- 89% of Y7 pupils preferred secondary French
- 11% of Y7 pupils preferred primary French


Multi-lingual approach



 Children create their own language portrait, highlighting the language influences in their lives




Discovering Languages






Latin



- Appropriate to the age of the children
- Provides insight into the structure and grammar of English and other modern European languages
- Extends English vocabulary
- Prepares for MFL
- Links to RE / History / General Knowledge / P4C
- Independent learning, research and ICT




Sophie is clever

- Understanding of grammar noun, verb, adjective
- Adjectival agreement
- Position of verb

English words derived from Latin

- Improves English vocabulary and reading comprehension
- Teaches how to work out meaning in future language learning





Y4 Spanish

- Natural progression from Latin in Y3
- Children already have an understanding of masculine and feminine nouns
- Enjoy speaking to each other in another language
- Sing songs, play games, write sentences

- Using a phonic approach to aid with pronunication
- Reading, writing, speaking & listening
- Children make comparisons with other languages
- Able to apply previous learning and look for patterns
- Springboard to text level once wider vocabulary is introduced
