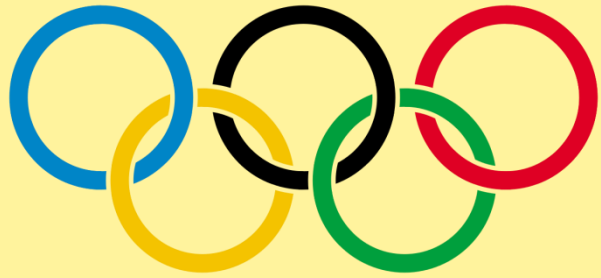

Your challenge...

You will be researching a sport or game from your target language country.

You will learn how to play the game to show it at a mini Olympics/showcase event to parents.

Start by researching a sport or game from your target language country.

Then think about learning:

- Vocabulary for equipment (ball, skipping rope)
- Vocabulary for names of player (e.g. referee, goal keeper)
- Vocabulary needed throughout the game (e.g. points, goal.)
- Instructions – can these be written using imperative verbs?
- Time adverbials – to sequence instructions

- Find all the equipment you need.
Is there anything you need to prepare
(e.g. score board in your target language)?
- Practice playing the game in your group.
Who will take which role?
Will you have a leader to call out instructions?
Will you take it in turns?
