Rachel Middleton


A former languages teacher and head of department, Rachel Middleton has been Director at ALL since September 2014. She joined ALL from the British Psychological Society where she was Director of Membership Services. he ALL Council plays an important governance role in the Association for Language Learning. It is broadly representative of the membership at large, including up to 14 members, as well as trustees and staff with a wealth of experience and expertise across languages, sectors, roles and geographical areas.

The functions of the Council are:

- To discuss and inform the Association's policies and strategies
- To contribute to the future development of the Association

 To consider proposals for new activities and make recommendations to the Board Last summer ALL produced a strategic vision for 2020 which identifies a range of objectives, in furtherance of our charitable object, which we'd like to achieve by 2020.

This is an ambitious piece of work and the Council's specific role is to split into 'task & finish' groups, identify tasks and achievable outcomes, and work on these for approximately an hour a week to enable ALL to move towards realising its vision.
