Yottsu no baketsu ni haitta mizu o nani ni tsukau ka kimete kudasai.

You are going to decide what you are going to do with four buckets of water.

You have got one, two, three, four buckets.

Hitotsu, futatsu, mitsu, yottsu no baketsu o motte imasu.

You are going to decide what you are going to do.

Sono mizu o nani ni tsukau ka, kimete kudasai.

But be careful.

Demo, Kiotsukete kudasai.

One bucket is five litres. OK?

Hitotsu no baketsu wa go-littoru desu. Ii desu ne?

You have got, here, on the sheet you have got four buckets, just like this.

Koko ni, kono yo ni yottsu no baketsu ga kami ni kakarete imasu.

On each bucket, write what you will do.

For example, "I am going to have a wash", that uses up five litres. OK?

Tatoeba, go-littoru no mizu o "karada o arau" tameni tsukai masu. Wakari masu ka.

Or, "I am going to do the washing up" and you write it down like this. OK?

Mata wa, "syokki o arau" nado to, kono yo ni kakikonde kudasai. Wakari masu ka.

And don't forget, once again, that it makes five, ten, fifteen, and twenty. OK?
