

How do I get my whole class to practice speaking & listening for the MFL GCSE Examination?

As class sizes continue to increase around the UK, teaching staff, for any subject area, are finding it increasingly difficult to spend as much time as they would like with every individual pupil. Nowhere is this issue more prominent than in the **Modern Foreign Languages** subject area.

By the very nature of the subject it involves every student to be **speaking and listening**, often as a class, and not every student can be always heard, additionally some students may not have the confidence to speak aloud in front of their classmates. In many countries



around the world Modern Foreign Languages is regarded as the first true multimedia subject as it must involve integrated audio in both speaking and listening. Finland is one of these countries, with a world leading educational system, where the acquisition of second or third language is considered the norm.

In Finland many schools turned to technology for help and use the latest **Sanako Study 1200** or **Sanako Study 700** software language labs. These systems maximise the time the teacher can spend with each student allowing them to both speak and listen, individually, as a pair, as an ability group or as a full class and then collect back all students work for assessment. At all times the teacher is discretely monitoring students to offer support as required.

The ability to monitor what students are working on is an incredible advantage for classroom management, and having the technology in the classroom to be able to talk to students individually or as a group will make **speaking tests much easier** to carry out. Students will be able to save their files on their electronic profile or to an examination folder.
