Microsoft Teams and OneNote	You can share resources and learning activities amongst teachers and with learners. Learners can submit completed work to teachers. Microsoft forms is a good way to create quizzes and low-stakes tests for learners.	Yes, as part of Microsoft Office
Google Classroom	You can share resources and learning activities amongst teachers and with learners. Learners can submit completed work. Edpuzzle - Allows teachers to make their lessons into a video and share them via Google Classroom to flip but also verify learning for misconceptions. https://edpuzzle.com/	No

Skype	This is free and providing you have users numbers calls can be made through skype video or audio. The app will need to be downloaded on to devices in order to be used. Zoom	A very easy online meeting space to have a face to face meeting with learners or other teachers from the comfort of your own home. Very easy to use and a code is generated, and online meeting place is sent out for others to join. Flipgrid	Flipgrid is an online platform which teachers can use to create videos to quiz and low stakes test learners. Students can respond to questions by creating their own videos. https://blog.flipgrid.com/news/remotelearning	Yes
