Grammar: high frequency verbs in the infinitive

Topics: animals, family, games

Grammar: verbs in the infinitive

## 6.La chaise bleue by Claude Boujon

Topic: colours, means of transport

Grammar: nouns, articles

### 7. Bon appétit Monsieur Lapin by Claude Boujon

Topic: animals, food items

Grammar: 1st person singular of high frequency verb

### 8. Cocotte tricote by Christine Beigel & Christine Destours

Topics: animals, colours, items of clothing

Grammar: adjectives of colour position and agreement
