She has experience as an Advisory Teacher, SLE and is the MFL tutor for a local SCITT programme. She has worked for AQA for over 15 years and is the Lead Examiner for AS Spanish Paper 1 and also delivers CPD for the board.

Andy Holland was Head of MFL for over twenty-two years in various settings in the UK, teaching both French and German to A Level. He now works for four exam boards as Principal Examiner for GCSE, AS and A Level French. He has written MFL resources for Languages for Learning, Hodder and Pearson, producing resources for A Level French speaking, A Level French and German film and literature, KS3, IGCSE and GCSE German.

Marie Massé is a Modern Foreign Languages consultant specialising in secondary education. She supports MFL departments in strengthening their curriculum, improving teaching and learning with a minimalist approach, and coaching individual teachers. With a wealth of classroom experience, Marie has served as Head of Languages, Subject Leader for French, and Trust Lead for MFL. She has taught A-Level French for 14 years, consistently achieving outstanding results and helping students thrive at the highest level by fostering autonomy and independence in the classroom, encouraging critical thinking, and sharing her passion for the ever-evolving landscape of French language and culture.

Clare Allison was involved in the set up and management of the HoLA Project at King Edward VII School before taking up her current post at the NCLE.
